"Queen Anne's War"</p> <p>1744 – 1748 War of Austrian Suc. "King George's War"</p> <p><b>1754:</b> French &amp; Indian War begins in America <b>1756 becomes the Seven Years War</b></p> <p>Ends 1763 – Treaty of Paris</p>	<p>1492 – Columbus' Voyage 1500s – Spanish, Portuguese, French, Dutch Colonization</p> <p>Roanoke Disaster – 1587 <b>Defeat of the Spanish Armada 1607</b></p> <p>Jamestown (Virginia) 1607 Plymouth Pilgrims 1620 Massachusetts Bay Puritans 1630 Maryland/Lord Baltimore 1634 1636 Rhode Island / Connecticut settled</p> <p>1663 – Carolina Colony settled 1664 – Dutch surrender "New Netherlands": become colonies of New York, New Jersey and Delaware 1681 – Pennsylvania founded</p> <p>South Carolina/North Carolina 1712</p> <p>1733 – Georgia founded (last colony)</p>	<p>1660 – <b>Navigation Acts</b> passed (begins mercantilism)</p> <p>1685 – Dominion of New England established; colonies protest mercantilism 1688 – William &amp; Mary repeal Dominion of NE, begins <b>"salutary neglect"</b></p> <p>1754 – French &amp; Indian War: American colonists defend frontier; friction develops with British (Albany Plan of Union 1754)</p> <p><b>1763 – Mercantilism returns; Proclamation line; end of Salutary Neglect and the Road to Revolution</b></p>
