Ira Berlin's "Generations of Captivity"

① CHARTER GENERATION

- Atlantic creoles
 - free laborers
 - early slaves
- (differs by time + place: wherever the "first" came)

② PLANTATION GENERATION

- harder life
- slave systems

Terms: • slave society vs. society with slaves
- create "planter aristocracy"

③ REVOLUTIONARY GENERATION

- even w/ more slave revolts, some success (Haiti) and ideas of freedom = SLAVERY GETS WORSE
