

## Instructions for enrolling in group site:

1. Go to <http://groups.google.com/group/summer-10-AH>
2. Select "Sign in and Apply for Membership"
3. Enter your Google Account log-in information **OR** select "Create an account"

### For creating an account:

- Enter the required information with a valid e-mail address
- You will have to access this e-mail when you get home to confirm the account
- De-select the checkbox labeled "keep me signed in" ← this is because you will often work with this account on a public computer in our library.

### VERY IMPORTANT: Once you have logged in with an existing account OR have created a new one:

- Select "**No E-mail**"
- For your nickname, enter your **First and Last Name**
- Click "**Apply to this Group**"
